Mark writes...


This year $12^{th} - 18^{th}$ May marks mental health awareness week in the UK. As part of this on Thursday 15^{th} May at 10AM in All Saints, we will hold a special service to commemorate this. This will be a quiet reflective service of the word which will last around 30 minutes followed by tea and coffee with a chance to talk.

I wanted to do this service to show people that it is ok to talk and that support is available to those who need it. It is also a chance for us to come together and pray for those who we know and love who have poor mental health and need our support.

This is very personal to me as two people very close to me have suffered with poor mental health in the past and one sadly tried to take his own life (he was thankfully unsuccessful) and so I want to share their stories with you.

This day (15th May) also happens to be wear it green day in aid of mental health awareness. Green is picked as the colour as it symbolises growth, renewal, and life, and in colour psychology, it is associated with qualities such as harmony, balance, and a sense of security. Therefore if you are planning on coming to the service, please feel free to wear something green.
