Our deanery is invited to join for a Taizé-style service at St Michael and All Angels Hackthorn on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> September at 7pm. It seemed a good opportunity to explain a little more about a Taizé style service for anyone who might be interested. It is a unique, quiet, and moving form of prayer developed by an ecumenical community of monks in France. A Taizé style service blends contemplative silence with simple, repeated musical chants, meditation, and scripture to help move prayer from the head to the heart. It is a peaceful service that combines elements of the traditional Liturgy of the Hours with contemplative meditation, seeking to offer a time of reflection and spiritual renewal. All are welcome.
