Reflective Prayer Space A Heartfelt Thank You: To all who have contributed their works of art to the Reflective Prayer Space—thank you. Your creativity has shaped a contemplative display that invites stillness and a doorway into encountering God.

This collection draws inspiration from the season of Autumn. In the Anglican Calendar, Autumn is honoured as the *Creation Season*—a time when the natural world becomes our teacher in the art of release.
